Class 5 - Gwenver Class Autumn Term Update

Before half term, we travelled to Trelissick Gardens for the day and experienced what life was like as a Viking.

The children listened to 'Viking Cadan' around the camp fire, where he spoke about his clothes, diet, fighting and hunting skills, duties and what life was like for him.

Our next activity was archery, we had to get our highest score, make a pizza (hitting the correct colour target) and lots of other fun games.

After that we headed over to the catapult building activity, as a group we were given wooden poles, lots of rope and and a 'launcher' arm! We learnt very quickly that the structure had to be secured well with tight knots in order for it to work efficiently.

We made shield walls (the shields were pretty heavy!) for protection as the rest of our group threw various authentic objects (otherwise known as ball-pool balls!) it was important that the shields stayed locked, ensuring no gaps could form

Although, all of this sounds quite gruesome, we are now also learning about the Vikings who travelled here to farm too!
