National TTrackstars competition

Last week, the children of St Hilary from Year 2 upwards, took part in a national TTrackstars competition in order to become the champion school, class or child. Over 18,000 classes across the country took part and it was a fierce tournament! It is the first year that we've engaged Year 2 in the resource in the bid to ensure children gain rapid recall of their times tables by the time they leave Year 4 where they will take part in a National Multiplication Check set by the government.

As ever, our children did themselves proud and we could not be happier with the results especially with ensuring the children receive a broad and balanced curriculum (and not just stuck on an iPad all day!) We appreciate all the support you have given your child during the week with their engagement in the competition.

Tegan C was nominated by Mrs Sandow because she greeted her with a friendly smile and was incredibly polite and well-mannered as always.

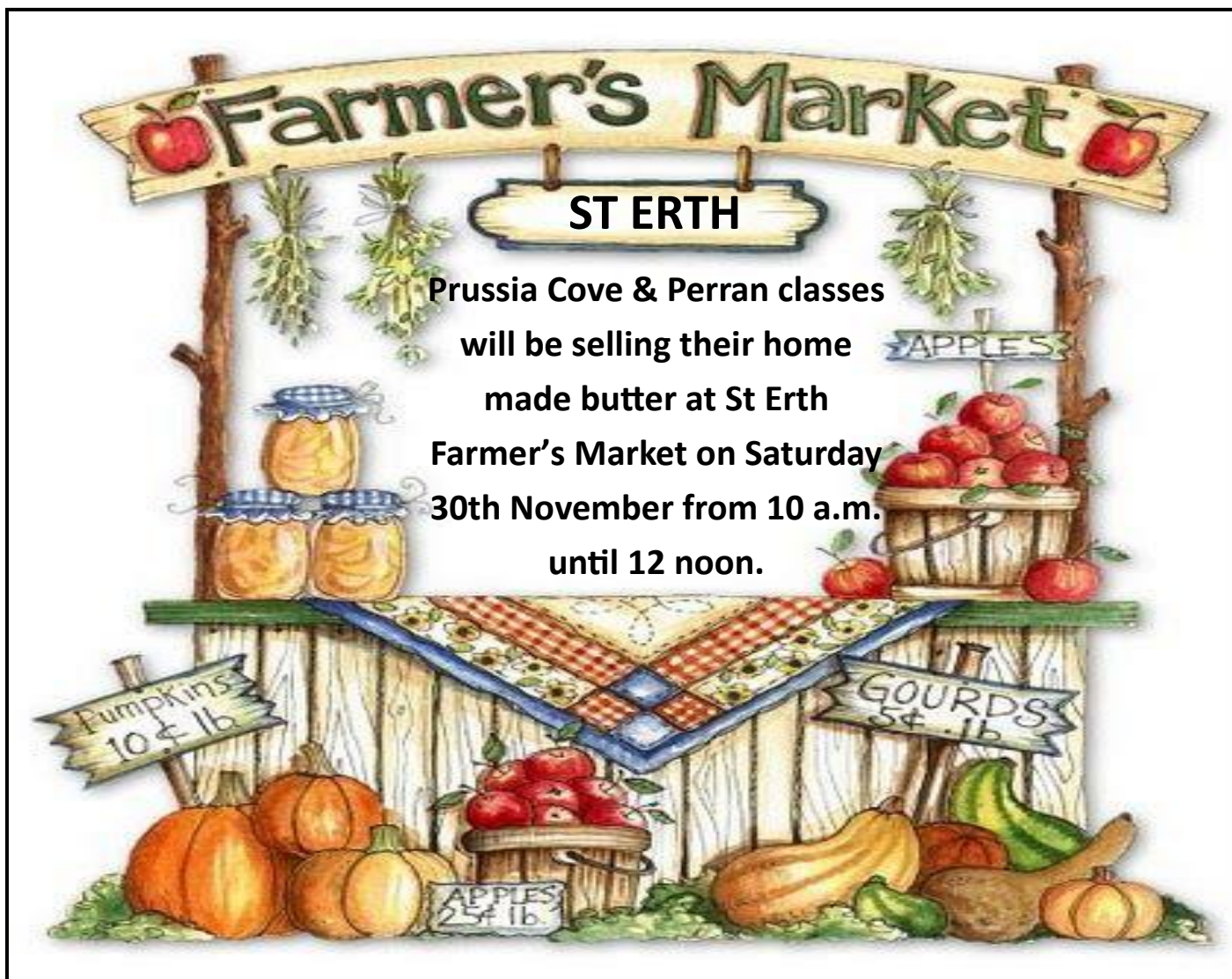
Brody T was nominated by Mrs Gardner because he is always polite and remembers his manners in breakfast club.
