PUPIL CONTACT INFORMATION

As you know we moved to the SIMS Parent Lite app for the purpose of complying with GDPR for collecting and managing pupil data from parents. What this means is that unless a parent comes in to request a paper copy of the data (the old data checking sheets) this is the only way we are informed of any changes.

In order to add/amend the information held for your child you will need to register for the app. This is done from an email that has already been sent, so if possible please could you register as soon as possible. If you have already registered, as a number of you have, **please do not go through the process again**.

The app is available on iOS, Android and a browser. The SIMS Parent Lite app provides a convenient and accessible solution for you to electronically review and request changes to the data held on your children.

Hopefully the instructions on the right will assist you with the process.
