## What's been going on in Perran and Prussia Cove?



What Makes a Hero Super? A question we have been exploring and discussing. We looked at both fantasy characters and real heroes in our lives. We reflected on Keyworkers during Lockdown and our favourite non-fiction superheroes.

In English, we have been listening and retelling non-fiction superhero themed books.

We can retell Charlie's Superhero Underpants story! We have created our own Superhero identities and costumes, pretended to be reporters and interviewed superheroes through role play, building on asking questions. We have also written our own Superhero stories.

In Mathematics we have developed our skills related to measure (weight, length and capacity) through a range of fun, challenging and practical activities. We are using and applying our number knowledge in a range of contexts (play, problem solving activities) and continuing to develop our skills in multiplication and division exploring halving and grouping.



We have been playing in and exploring our local natural world through a range of activities. Wellie Walks and time in the woods have provided opportunities supporting our topic of Plants, Minibeasts and Caring For Our World.



We continue to build on our ball and athletic skills in PE and are looking forward to our sporty, active charity fundraising Superhero Day!

The children are settled and back in the flow of their daily and weekly routines. Independence and relationships are threads running through all our lessons and learning. Children are clearly becoming confident, independent and ready for their transition up the school.



# CENSUS DAY UNIVERSAL INFANT FREE SCHOOL MEALS

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR KS1 PARENTS:** It's National School Census Day on Thursday 20th May 2021. This is when the Department for Education (DfE) collects information about each school to help them plan for the future and, most importantly, the data is used to set future school budgets.

One of the figures we have to report is the number of Reception and Year's 1 & 2 children having a Universal Infant Free School Meal (UIFSM) on this day. The census data is then used to decide how much funding for the year we get for our hot meals. This means that if your child does not have a meal on Thursday, we will not receive any further funding for the rest of the year. If your child chooses to have a meal on another day, we will have to fund this from our school budget.

We do not receive funding for the amount of hot meals we supply, the funding we receive is based only on the number of meals eaten on the two census days in October and January each year. To face this challenge head-on, we ask every child in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 to try the hot meal on Census Day. This means your child will then be fully funded to have hot meals throughout the year thus saving the school any additional costs.

Your child can have access to a School Nurse at any time if you have any health concerns, in addition your School Nurse offers a full health assessment in reception and year 6.

## The School Nurse can check:

- Your child is growing healthily and support with healthy eating
- Support with access to dental care and general support for dental hygiene
- Help with day / night time wetting or soiling
- Provide information about immunisations
- Guidance re healthy lifestyles
- Support with general hygiene issues including head lice and worms
- Support with general emotional health issues
- Support to access other health professionals
- Routines, including sleep

## Additionally in Year 6:

- Friendships
- Relationships
- Development, including periods and puberty
- Access to specialist services – including dietician, healthy weight programmes and voluntary services
- Developmental issues
- Transition to secondary school
- Healthy lifestyles
