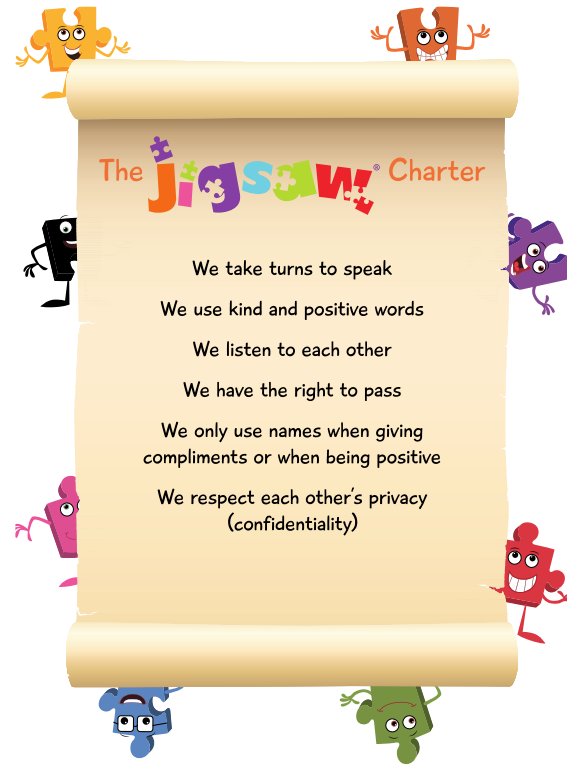


# Year 6 Jigsaw Unit 2 Celebrating Difference

<b>Bullying</b>	Being unkind or hurtful towards another person.
<b>Celebrate</b>	To do something special or enjoyable for an important event, occasion, holiday, etc.
