National TTrockstars competition

Last week, the children of St Hilary from Year 2 upwards, took part in a national TTrockstars competition in order to become the champion school, class or child. 31,039 classes across the Country took part and it was a fierce tournament! It is the second year that we've engaged Year 2 in the resource in the bid to ensure children gain rapid recall of their times tables by the time they leave Year 4 where they will take part in a National Multiplication Check set by the government.

As ever, our children did themselves proud and we could not be happier with the results especially with ensuring the children receive a broad and balanced curriculum (and not just stuck on an iPad all day!) . We appreciate all the support you have given your child during the week with their engagement in the competition.
