Alongside our 'Leading Edge' partner schools, we have been asked to take part in an exciting pilot project in partnership with Cornwall Council Library and Information Service. This is an opportunity for all of our children to have free access to e-books and e-audiobooks through the 'Borrowbox' library app. There are no overdue charges, no loan charges and it is completely free! All of the books are deemed to be in the 5-11 year age range and contain a great mixture of authors and types of books.

Over the next few weeks, we will be issuing the children with the membership number which will be put into the front of their planners. Each child in the school will be given an electronic library card number which will enable them to download books using the school iPads during the school day and will also enable them to access the book from home if a mobile device is available. Just like in a real library, some books will have waiting lists and if a child would like to read a book which is not available immediately then they can click '**Reserve**' and add themselves to the queue. They will have an amount of time to read the book before it will need to be 'returned', although books can be renewed if they have not been finished.

Once your child has been allocated a membership number, we will send home instructions for using the app.

Whilst there is much merit in having a 'physical book', this is a great alternative - particularly with the audio books and we are really excited to be able to provide such an alternative.

The SIMS Parent app – easy access to important school information

Following GDPR we introduced a secure and convenient way to update important pupil contact information that you will be able to access which is called SIMS Parent app and website

You can access the system from a smartphone, tablet or PC – anytime, anywhere.

The App will allow you access to update your contact details, change of address etc so we always have the most up-to-date information in case of emergency. If you are unable to access the app you can request a Data Checking sheet but you will have to come in to the school office to pick it up. Please ensure you do make changes when they occur.

If you have more than one child at school, you will have access to information for all your children, from the same app.

Getting started with the SIMS Parent app

You have already had an activation email (if you can't find it please contact the school office), simply click the link from your tablet, PC or smartphone to activate your account.

You can then login using your normal **Facebook, Twitter, Google** or **Microsoft** username and password.
