'School Gateway' Parent APP

Particularly in a school, good communication is absolutely paramount and we believe that strong communication and positive relationships between school and home helps children to learn and succeed.

At St Hilary, we have a number of systems in place to help with communication: through the website, emails, texts, newsletter, school planners, phone and of course face to face. As part of the emailing and texting package that we have been using for a few years now we now have the ability to use a 'parent app'. In reality, the app has been around for a little while but was more limited in its usage.

Through the APP, we are now able to send messages from school to home (at no cost to the school), provide a link to our school calendar and to our social networking sites. By the end of this year, we also hope to be able to use this for booking clubs, Funzone, breakfast club and for booking parent meetings.

In order to download the APP,

Go to your usual APP store (android or apple) and search for 'school gateway'.

Download the APP.




'Sign up' using the email which is registered at St Hilary- *NB. the system will not let you 'sign up' if the email is not the one registered to St Hilary.*

You will then be able to access the school calendar, quick link to the school website and the school Facebook and Twitter sites. Whenever we send a message out to parents, this will pop up as a notification via the APP. The huge advantage to the school is that we are currently charged for every text which we send out.

Receiving the same messages via the APP is completely free to the school which in turn allows this money to be spent within the school.

NASAL FLU

Kernow Health were due to deliver the flu immunisation on Monday 7th October 2019 on behalf of NHS England here in school, but unfortunately have had to put this off. They will notify us as soon as they have another date available. In the meantime they will keep our school open online for an extended period for any parents who have not yet opted in for their child to have the vaccine which this year is for all children from Reception to Year 6. The letter you have already received (see below), advises about the vaccine programme and also how to access the online consent form. As in previous years you have to **opt in** if you want your child to have the vaccine. Ignore the sign up by date on the letter, as mentioned above, this has now been extended.

Dear Parent/Guardian

Your child's annual nasal flu vaccination is now due

Kernow Health is delivering the flu immunisation programme in Cornwall's schools on behalf of NHS England. Flu can be an unpleasant illness and sometimes causes serious complications. Vaccinating your child will also help protect more vulnerable friends and family by preventing the spread of flu.

In 2019/2020 all children in Primary Schools from **Reception to year 6 (inclusive)** will be offered the vaccine. The vaccination is free and recommended for young children; it is administered by a quick and simple spray up the nose. Please click on the following [link](#) to access information explaining the vaccination programme which also includes details about the small number of children for whom the nasal vaccine is not appropriate.

Please submit your consent form by Monday 30th September to ensure your child receives their vaccination. If you experience any problems accessing the form please telephone 01872 221105/06 and the team will be happy to help. Please note that as in previous years you must **opt in** to the programme. If a consent form is not submitted your child will not be vaccinated.

If your child becomes wheezy or has their asthma medication increased after you submit this form, please contact Kernow Health on one of the numbers above.

If you decide you do not want to vaccinate your child against flu, please complete and submit the consent form giving the reason. This will help us to plan and improve the service. Please tell us if you need this information in a different format.
